1. What Are Cookies?

3. Types of Cookies We Use

Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are essential for the Website to function and cannot be switched off. They are typically set in response to your actions. You cannot opt out of strictly necessary cookies.

Consent required: No — these are operationally essential

Duration: Session (deleted when you close your browser)

Performance and analytics cookies

These cookies collect anonymized information about how visitors use our Website, helping us understand which pages are most popular and identify areas for improvement. All information collected is aggregated and does not identify individual visitors.

Consent required: Yes — you may opt out via our cookie banner or browser settings

Duration: Up to 26 months

Functionality cookies

These cookies allow the Website to remember choices you make in order to provide a more personalized experience.

Consent required: Yes — opting out may affect certain Website features

Duration: Up to 12 months

Marketing and targeting cookies

These cookies may be set by us or our trusted third-party partners to track your activity across websites and to deliver content relevant to your professional interests. We will only place these cookies with your explicit consent.

Consent required: Yes — explicit consent required before placement

Duration: Up to 24 months

Please note that restricting cookies may affect the functionality of our Website and other sites you visit.
